In your groups, you will be assigned <u>three</u> different words from the vocabulary list. For each word you will complete the following:

- 1. On your graphic organizer write down the word you are researching
- 2. Look up the definition. Write the definition in the space provided, but in your own words
- 3. Write a sentence using the vocabulary word. In the sentence you must show you understand its meaning
- 4. Generate three different synonyms for the vocabulary word.
- 5. Finally, create a PictoWord
 - a. A PictoWord is an image that illustrates the meaning of the word, but also uses the word within the image.
 - b. Example: If your vocabulary word is "cat", the PictoWord can be the letters from cat drawn as the animal.
 - c. You <u>must</u> use the letters of the word in the picture.
 - d. You must draw an image which shows some part of the meaning behind the word.
- 6. You will complete these steps for each of the three words your group is assigned.
- 7. Your group will then take one word (which has already been selected) and create a poster of a larger version of its PictoWord, which will be hung in the classroom.
- 8. At the end of class your group will present and share the words you researched.
